Was a publicist for Selznick Studios and CBS working on movies and television.

Francis Michael McDonaugh: Carlton's Grandfather.

Was a well known poet and writer for the Nebraska Watchman who had several books published.

Edward Lysaght: Francis' Grandfather.

Was an Irish lawyer who was better known for playing his songs and reading his poetry down at the local Pub. Had several books published.

Andy Smith continues in the family tradition as the class poet, songwriter and author of books, plays, columns and articles. He will be today what his Dad was to early television, Hermes was to musicals, Paul was to Vaudeville, Carlton and Francis were to the early days of newspapers and Edward was to that little pub in Ireland.......
